School Attendance / Academic Performance

- Chronic tardiness; excessive absences; cutting class; increased suspensions
- Decline in school performance – slow to respond, forgetful, and/or drop in grades
- Reduced short-term memory, concentration and/or attention span

Behavioral

- Inappropriate behavior in class – lack of participation, increased behavioral problems
- Excessive activity, touches everything, easily distracted
- Inattentive, daydreams, withdrawn, disorganized work habits
- Failure to comply with rules
- Aggressive, explosive, temper tantrums, cussing, threats, fighting

Social / Emotional

- Poor self-image
- Inappropriate responses and comments
- Impulsive, uses poor judgment
- Unexplained periods of moodiness, depression, irritability and / or over sensitivity
- Defies adult authority
- Easily frustrated
- Relates poorly to peers

Physical Appearance

- In violation of appropriate attire/behavior (wearing gang colors, flashing signs, tattoos, etc.)
- Neglects personal appearance
- Sudden weight loss or decreased appetite

Substance Abuse (Suspected or known)

- Student has been seen or is known to use drugs/alcohol or sell drugs
- Seemingly intoxicated–i.e. smell of marijuana/alcohol, red, droopy eyes, dilated pupils, erratic eye movements – constantly wears sunglasses

Grief, Depression, Loss (Suspected or known)

- Student is known to have lost someone close to them
- Student appears unhappy, depressed
